Join us for a presentation with Dr. Patricia Rosas Lopátegui, an Assistant Professor in the UNM Department of Chicana and Chicano Studies.

Lopátegui teaches courses on Literature and Journalism in Mexico, Chicano and World Cinema, and Transgressive Women in Mexican Literature, among others. Her work focuses on the preservation and publication of the writings of Mexican women authors, particularly that of Elena Garro, but also Nahui Olin and recently Guadalupe Dueñas. Her published work includes the recent biography *El asesinato de Elena Garro. Periodismo a través de una perspectiva biográfica (2014)* and the compilation Óyeme con los ojos. De Sor Juana al siglo XXI. 21 escritoras mexicanas revolucionarias, among others. In this presentation, Lopátegui will address the poetry of Elena Garro, a transgressive and pioneering Mexican author whose feminist writings confronted patriarchy in 20th century Mexico.
