- Proposed travel itinerary
- Budget. Awards will generally be capped at \$3,000. However, higher amounts may be considered for longer-term projects depending on funding availability. Scholars planning extended stays that require funding beyond the capped amount are strongly encouraged to seek supplementary support from other sources. The award can be applied to round-trip travel plus local living expenses (lodging, meals, and incidentals) capped at \$160/day. The minimum stay is two weeks. Please note that the Center for Southwest Research and Special Collections is not open on the weekends and summer hours are limited.

- One faculty letter or recommendation (student applicants only)
